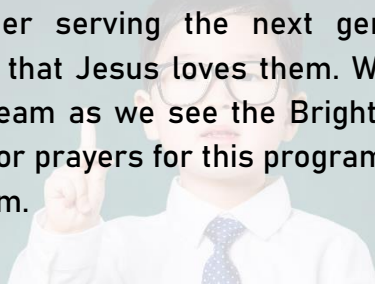

Growing in Faith

Acts 2:36-41

With the new sound system and the new streaming equipment that was recently installed, we have a renewed and improved opportunity to spread the word of God to anyone who has access to the radio and the internet. "Evangelism thru broadcasting" has opened the door for millions of unchurched to hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ and know Him. To know that He is "the way and the truth and the life, and no one comes to the Father but through [Him]" (Jn 14:6). Peter taught the crowd in Acts 2 who the Jesus, that they crucified, truly was. The people "were cut to the heart" (Acts 2:36) and Peter directed them to repent and be baptized so that they could receive the gift of the Holy Spirit (Act 2:38). Just as Peter taught the crowds, we can do the same. In Acts 2:39 the scripture says, "The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call."
